# Château HAUT PIQUAT

Lussac Saint Emilion

#### Grapes

80% Merlot 15% Cabernet Sauvignon 5% Cabernet Franc

#### Localisation :

It is situated at the edge of the village of Lussac and is mainly located on sunny hillsides.

Owner : Jean Pierre Rivière

Surface : 22 Ha

Soil : gravel on the plain and red sandy clay on the hillsides.

## Vinification

Grass-growing, green harvesting. After the grapes have been stalked they are gently crushed. Then they ferment for a period of 3 weeks in temperature controlled stainless steel vats.

During the the fermentation the wine is mixed with the lees 3 or 4 times a day in order to ensure optimum extration of the best tannins and good colour from the grapes. The wine is aged in oak barrels.

## Tasting

Ideally located, Château HAUT PIQUAT produces a fine and generous good-keeping wine with a deep purple colour, a complex nose of red fruits and vanilla. The aromas are balanced and harmonious. The nose is confirmed by the palate. Excellent length.
